# THE PALM OF ALPHA TAU OMEGA

FLASH! With pleasure we report that the chapters voted their enthusiastic approval of the petition of Theta Kappa Beta, local at Louisiana State University, and that this fraternity will be installed as Epsilon Zeta chapter of Alpha Tau Omega Feb. 10-11.

Installing officers will be Roy Watson, Chief of Province X, and Major Christianity Pickett, Michigan, professor of military science and tactics at L.S.U. The initiation ceremony will be put on by the Tulane chapter.

Theta Kappa Beta was organized Sept. 28, 1919, and in the years since has maintained a strong position on the L.S.U. campus. Its undergraduate members have been leaders in athletics, student organizations, and military activities, while scholastically the fraternity has ranked well up toward the head of the list. For the past three years Theta Kappa Beta has stood fourth among L.S.U. social fraternities in scholastic average.

At present there are 21 national fraternities at L.S.U. and three locals. The enrollment of the university now exceeds 8,000 students, about 25 per cent of whom are fraternity members. The Theta Kappa Beta chapter averages between 20 and 30 members, and there are 211 alumni, located mostly throughout the states of Louisiana, Mississippi, and Texas.
